
### There's no sugar coating 2020



# Menehune House Rules

The following is a summary of Kihei Kai Nani's House Rules adopted for your convenience. Lack of compliance can result in fines to the owner(s) and or guest(s). Observing the rules makes everyone's stay more pleasant.

ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING IN ANY UNIT, LANAI, POOL AREA, BUILDINGS OR GROUNDS EXCEPT IN THE 2 DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS, PLEASE USE THEM. MANAGEMENT HAS THE AUTHORITY TO FINE GUEST/OWNER \$50.00 PER INCIDENT.

QUIT TIME: 10:00pm to 8:00am. Please help maintain a peaceful atmosphere. Hawaii's air is very thin. Even light talking after 10 pm can be heard several buildings away. If others disturb your stay after 10 pm, call staff (security) between 10 pm and 2 am at 808-870-4241.

#### **APARTMENT AREAS:**

- 1. NOTHING SHALL BE HUNG FROM THE LANAI RAILING.
- 2. State law prohibits the feeding of any birds and animals on the property.
- 3. Barbecuing is only permitted at provided permanent barbecue stands.
- 4. Using recreational objects and playing on walkways, stairways, stairwells, sidewalks, parking areas, and roadways are prohibited.

#### GENERAL PROPERTY AREAS:

- 1. Loud noise is not permitted anytime. If it disturbs others you will be contacted and asked to reduce the noise level.
- 2. All refuse, garbage, and trash must be placed in the provided containers.
- 3. No Skating, Skateboarding, or Playing catch in the common area.
- 24. Damages to any part of the complex shall be paid for by the person(s) causing the damage and/or by the work of the unit.
- 5. Laundry Room facilities are for the Kihei Kai Nani owners and guests only.

#### POOL AREA:

There is **NO LIFEGUARD** at the pool. NOTE: ALL pool rules are posted at the pool area.

- 1. People using the pool and pool area use it at their own risk and liability.
- 2. Pool hours: 9 am to 9 pm. No running, diving, or loud pool games.
- 23. Parents and guardians are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children. Children under 13 may not use the pool without adult supervision.
- 4. Incontinent adults and non-toilet trained children shall wear rubber pants when in the pool. Violators will lose pool privileges.
- 5. More than two nonresidents guest per unit must have Site Manager approval to use the pool.
- 6. Small "diving toys" get stuck in our pump and are not allowed in the pool.
- 7. SWIM FINS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE POOL AT ANY TIME.
- 8. Marco Polo games are not allowed at any time.

\*PARKING AREAS: All cars and motorcycles must have a parking permit. (one space per unit) Mopeds and Motorcycles must park at the west end of buildings #1 and #2 or by the bicycle rack. Vehicle maintenance and repairs on the premises are prohibited. The maximum speed limit is 5mph on-premises. Violators can be fined.
